26 Consonant Sounds

Group 1: Plosives - like a little stop or explosion



Group 4: Affricates - stop + vibrations



Group 5: Lateral

- air flows past the side of the tongue



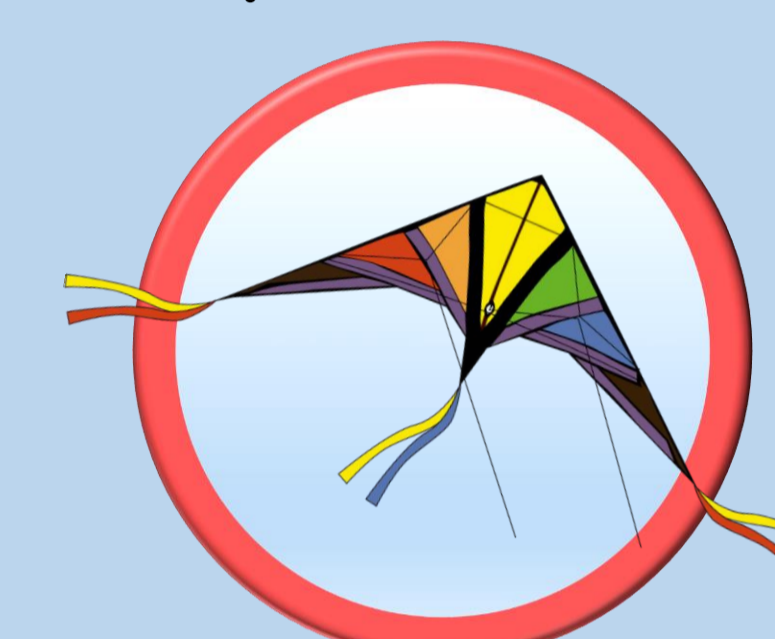
Group 2: Nasals - made through the nose

' Indicates whispered sound	Silent letters	* Indicates voiced sound	

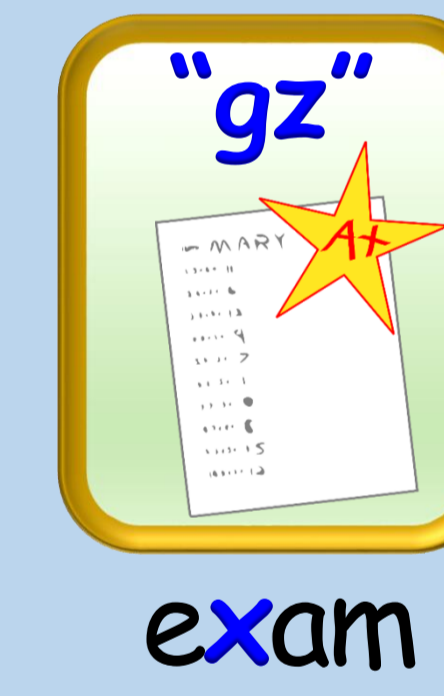
Group 6: Glides - goes smoothly into or from another sound

Group 7: Combination of Sounds

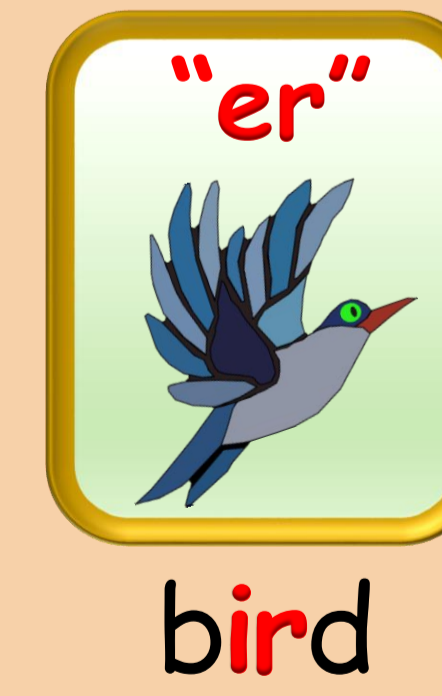

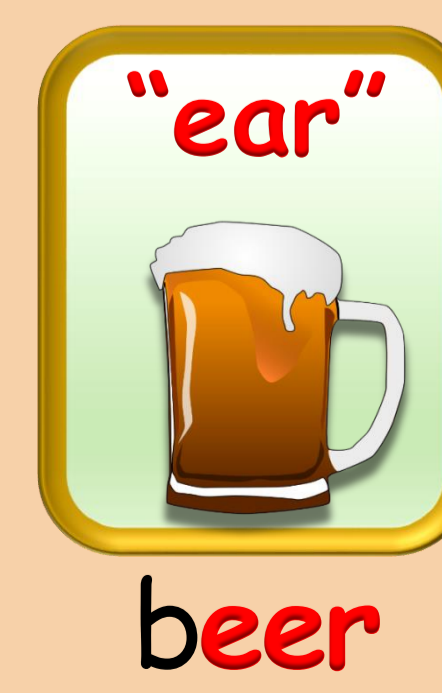
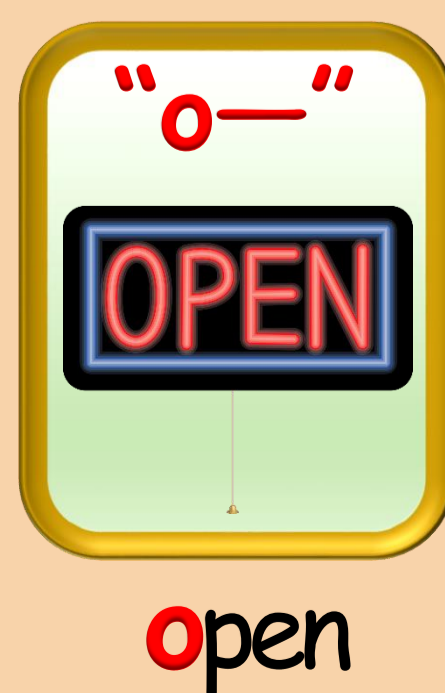
Group 1: Short "- Vowel Sounds
